




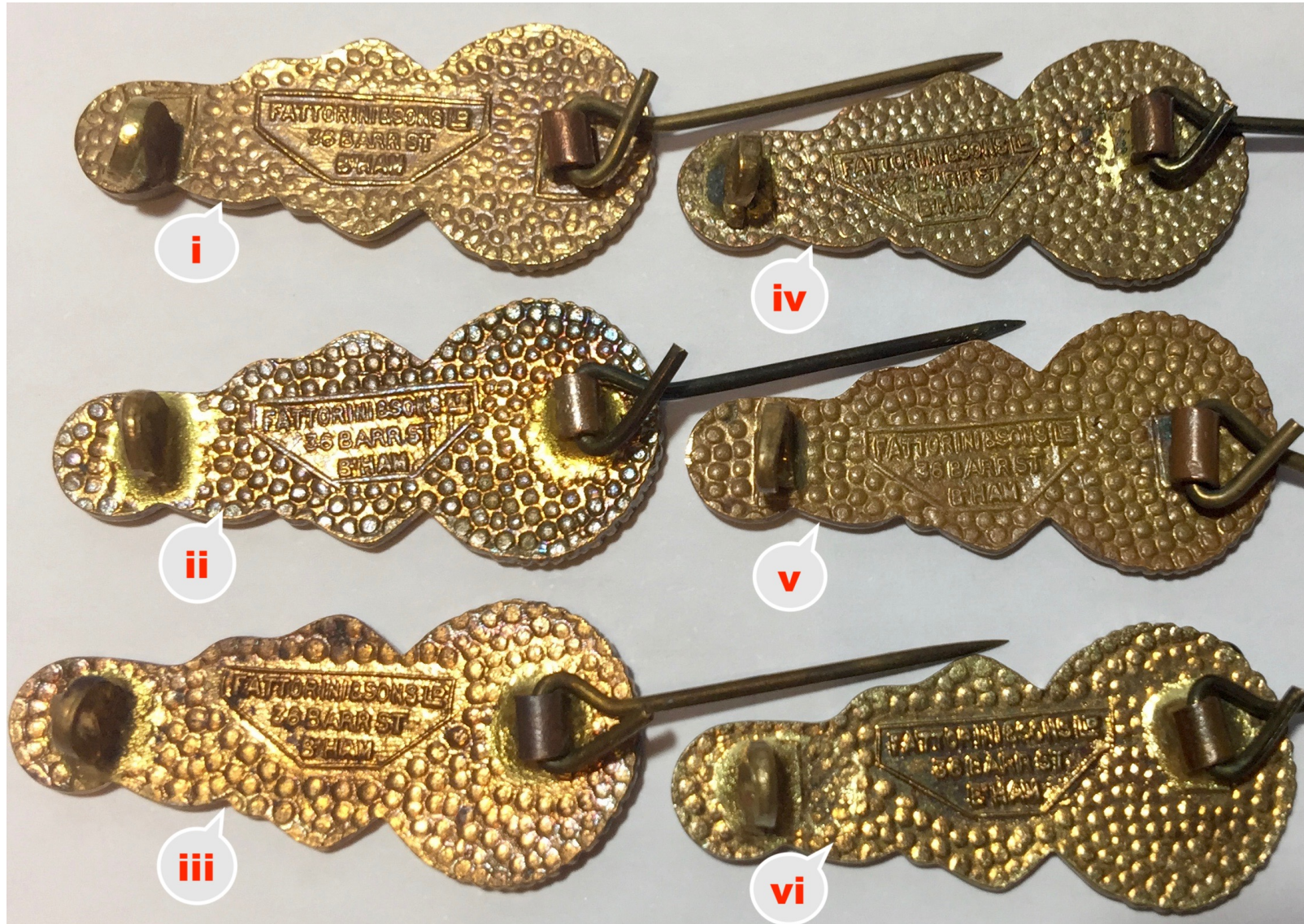
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## Research Note: 1002

Section	Golly Badges: W/W era	Title	Fattorini [3]
Description	The Fattorini bobble back stamping [Fattorini type 3] is one of the more attractive backstamps and only occurs on the white waistcoat Standard. It is currently catalogued as 4 different variants [3a-1], [3a-2], [3a-3] & [3a-4]. However it has recently been discovered that variations exist within this – in particular in relation to the patterns of the bobbles on reverse. How many there are is not yet known and requires further investigation.

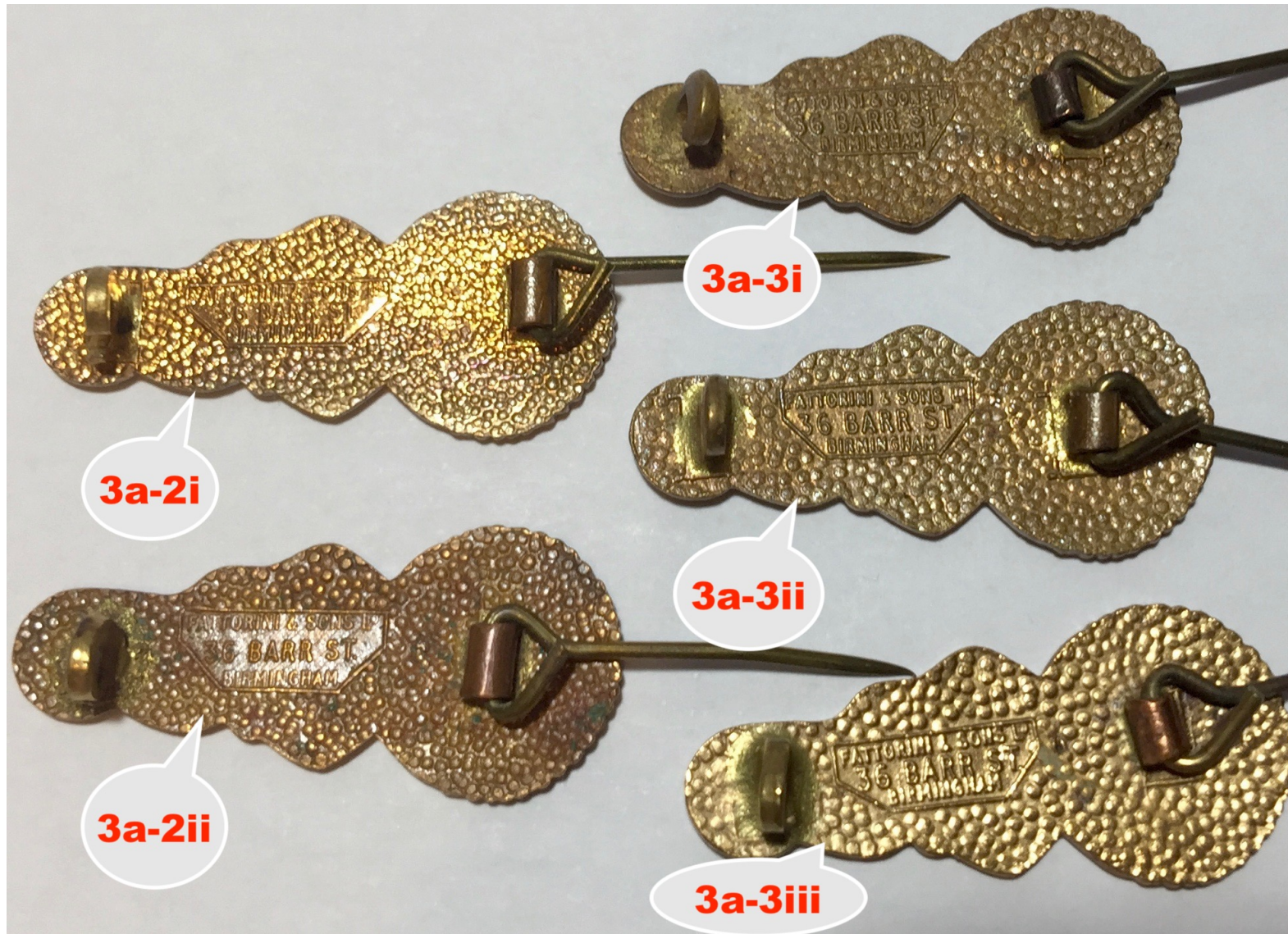
