Section	Golly badges: W/W era
Title	Gomm – b/s alignment
Description	The REV Gomm backstamp can be found with a horizontal or vertical alignment. Is there any consistency of alignment across designs, are all badge designs which have the Gomm stamp available with both H & V alignments?
Further Detail	The image below (1.) shows the Guitarist with REV Gomm backstamps. Although the right hand image does not have a very clear stamp it is sufficient to show it as being horizontally stamped. The vertical stamp becomes horizontal by rotating the badge to the right – this is referred to as VERTICAL-RIGHT. Does it also exist with a VERTICAL-LEFT stamping? There are three possible alignments (HORIZONTAL, VERTICAL-RIGHT and VERTICAL-LEFT) - do all REV Gomm badges have all possible alignments? Once a sufficient number of reports of other instances have been received we will draw up a table with all known variations.
